



An Above Average Distinction

All swing states, with the exception of one, were part of the 24 states that experienced above-average voter turnout in 2024. Arizona is the only swing state that had below-average turnout. Additionally, all **four** states that had both above-average turnout and an increase in turnout were swing states. Presidential candidates often focus their campaigns on key swing states, frequently holding multiple rallies there, while non-swing states may not receive any visits from candidates during the campaign season.
